Why Study horary?

Discovering horary: astrology's key to powerful analysis & practical guidance

Horary astrology, renowned for its precision and clarity, provides immediate and practical solutions to pressing life questions. This branch of astrology uses a chart drawn for the time that a question is asked about a matter of significant concern is expressed. The interpretive techniques enable a swift yet detailed and focused assessment of the situation, offering reliable guidance so the questioner (querent) knows how best to proceed or what to expect. To illustrate, the STA course features numerous real client charts exploring questions such as:

- *What are the prospects of this relationship?*
- *Will I gain or lose money pursuing the lawsuit?*
- *Will it be profitable to invest in this property?*
- *Where is my missing partner – is he safe, and when will I hear from him?*

Horary offers unique and valuable guidance for locating lost objects, missing people or pets, while addressing a vast range of other concerns: relationships, health, finances, career, property, legal matters, personal challenges, etc. The analysis often involves a need to time the progression and outcome of future developments with confidence, and the STA offers especially illuminating guidance on this, supported by examples that demonstrate horary's impressive ability to anticipate how situations unfold.

While often used to offer concrete advice on mundane matters, horary is equally effective as a diagnostic and counselling tool. Its traditional principles blend naturally with modern psychological perspectives, providing a solid and enriching foundation for astrological consultations. Generally regarded as astrology's most predictive branch for its distinctive strength in delivering clear and specific answers, horary's philosophy nonetheless emphasises informed choice over fatalism. Respected historical theologians, such as Saint Albertus Magnus, lent philosophical support to its theory and practice because it encourages thoughtful decision-making and reinforces the importance of

recognising free will and directing it with conscious intent. In fact, horary analysis frequently begins by exploring past events, since deeper insight can reveal root causes, highlight new routes for improvement, or clarify how best to manage unavoidable outcomes.

The STA Practitioners Level Horary Course has earned the trust of many of the world's leading astrologers, who recognise that mastery of horary is an essential component of fully supporting client needs. However, using horary effectively requires a firm and uncluttered understanding of principles that are often poorly conveyed or made unnecessarily complex and contradictory. It calls for committed engagement with well-shaped, structured instruction that builds understanding through digestible, demonstrated explanations. The rewards are well worth the effort: horary's historical authority, practical benefits, and profound symbolic insights offer immense value – particularly when combined with a sound understanding of its metaphysical philosophy and the ethical considerations it entails.

Ultimately, studying horary deepens knowledge of astrology's rich heritage and sharpens interpretive skill at every level. It strengthens symbolic awareness and enhances technique across all branches of astrology, including natal, mundane, electional, and decumbiture. As such, this course offers a natural foundation for engaging in any element of traditional astrology and serves as an ideal starting point for students preparing to enter professional client work, while also enriching the insight and focus of even the most seasoned practitioners.

ABOUT THIS HORARY COURSE

The STA offers a unique tutorial format in which the principles of horary are demonstrated through client charts and informative historical examples. Explanations of the philosophical tenets and traditional techniques lie at the heart of the study, but the psychological significance of problems are also shown to be important and explored where appropriate. The course is highly practical and geared towards the consulting needs of modern-day astrologers. Whilst showing the best approach to reading a chart, it also focuses on preparing for the sensitive issues that arise in consultation.

This course is not targeted at astrological novices, but we don't require that astrologers who wish to take the course must have previous experience in horary – the course provides a full theoretical overview and highlights the most useful and reliable principles of judgment.

Lessons take the form of tutorials with follow-up discussions, chart examples, and practical exercises. Throughout, students are taught how to extract meaningful details and sharpen their judgment, and each lesson allows the opportunity to consolidate what is taught through periods of practical application. The course is designed to offer knowledge of traditional doctrines in a balanced way so that theoretical principles enlighten and facilitate (rather than overwhelm) the creative aspect of horary interpretation.

It offers practitioner-level certification so that by the end of the course any astrologer who is already providing a professional astrology service will be ready to begin offering horary to clients.



SYLLABUS:

The format of this course has been specially developed to maximise the advantages of online delivery. Twenty session themes are delivered weekly through a combination of supplied course notes, modern media presentations, online tutorials, and set assignments. Each student studies at their own pace and in their own time – but always with easy access to tutor support and the benefit of supplementary study-group discussion.

A typical session includes: a live presentation (attendance is optional – it is recorded and can be watched or reviewed in your own time); a reading and self-study assignment; workbook activities or example charts to help you prepare for the session assignment; an online assignment to test your understanding of the session's key principles; and an 'Answer Key' document, which provides follow-up material and further explanation of points you will have explored through the assignment. Tutors deliver and guide the weekly content, reviews student assignments, gives personalized feedback, and remain available for questions and support. LECTURE SCHEDULE



COST & ENROLMENTS





POLICIES, REQUIREMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS

- Whilst previous experience of horary is not required, this course offers professional level training. It is unsuitable for students who are new to astrology or lack experience in drawing up charts. Participants must have a solid grasp of core astrological principles, including the symbolic and theoretical concepts of planets, signs, houses, aspects and transits (see below for more detail).
- Participants must be at least 18. Because horary addresses life concerns and emotional dilemmas, involves ethical sensitivities. Some case studies involve distressing themes such as trauma or death, so anyone in a vulnerable emotional state is advised to consider this carefully before enrolling.
- Chart calculation is not taught in this syllabus, except for horary-specific techniques (e.g. planetary hours, orbs, dignity scoring). Participants are expected to know how to draw up and interpret charts. The example below reflects the format used: applicants should be able to see that the Moon is separating from a trine with the Sun and applying to a square with Mars (perfecting in 1°50'), and lies within 1° of the 9th house cusp. It should also be clear that Venus is cadent but dignified by sign, and that if placed in Aries, it would be in detriment. (*Anyone unable to follow this level of narrative should gain more experience before commencing*)
- This English-language course includes over 400 A4 pages of notes and 40+ hours of live, interactive instruction. The main tutors are American, Australian and New Zealander (with corresponding accents), so a fluent understanding of English is essential.
- Students should expect to commit approximately 6–8 hours per week to study. Our qualifying certificate is only awarded to students who demonstrate engagement with the material by completing the set assignments. (Students who do not complete the work within two weeks after the course ends may have up to 6 months to revise or catch up for an additional fee.)
- Course materials are delivered as serialised PDF downloads. All texts, diagrams, and study materials are copyrighted and provided for personal use only – no part may be reproduced, amended, or circulated in any form. To protect the confidentiality of all participants, recorded tutorial videos are not downloadable and can only be accessed via our secure course portal. Students retain extended access to the portal and its resources for 12 months after the course ends, but tutorial support ends upon course completion.
- Course materials are checked for compatibility with modern computers, but assignment submission may not function on mobile phones or reduced-capacity tablets, and we do not provide technical support for these devices. Students are expected to have access to a printer and reliable internet, as all coursework is completed via the STA Course Portal, and live sessions are conducted through Zoom (www.zoom.us).
- In the two weeks before the course starts, students are required to read our Welcome Pack and view a 30- minute video explaining how to enrol, access materials, navigate the course site, and submit assignments.
- Places secured by deposit must be paid in full by the advertised deadline; if not, we may offer the place to another applicant. If a student changes their mind, a refund is permitted within 30 days of the original payment. This covers the full amount received by STA but excludes non-refundable payment platform fees (e.g. PayPal, Stripe) incurred as part of your payment. No refunds are granted after this 30-day period or once any course materials have been issued. Because places are limited and enrolments close once the course is full, deposits become non-refundable and non-transferable after the 30-day 'cooling off' period.
- In the unlikely event that the course is cancelled or postponed, STA will refund all course fees and deposits, but cannot be held liable for any additional personal costs incurred by participants. In the event of circumstances beyond our control (e.g. illness, technical failures, extreme weather, or other force majeure events), we reserve the right to adapt, withdraw or reschedule elements of the course as necessary.
